## CLASSES

### **IN HAND CLASSES - 9.30am Judge Mrs Ruth Eastwood (Gowbarrow)**

Class 1: Novice In hand Pony – Any age, never to have won a FIRST prize. (This class is designed for totally novice ponies who need experience in the ring – PLEASE DO NOT ABUSE THIS – Thank you) 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> winners eligible for relevant age championship

Class 2: Stallions (4 years plus must be fully licensed and bitted)

Class 3: Two & Three year old colts (All must be bitted)

Class 4: Yearling Colt, Filly or Gelding

Class 5: Two Year Old Filly or Gelding

Class 6: Three Year Old Filly or Gelding

Class 7: Mares without foal at foot, 4 years and over

Class 8: Mare with foal at foot

Class 9: Foal (To be at least 3 weeks old on show day and eligible for registration in the main section of the Fell Pony Stud Book)

Class 10: Geldings, 4 years and over

Class 11: Veteran (15 years and over)

### **Group Classes:**

**NB Ponies must have pre-entered the show in other classes to compete. Owners of ponies must be current members of the FPS irrespective of who exhibits or handles the ponies.**

Class 12: Progeny – Best group (minimum of two) of Registered Ponies by the same Sire, Mare or same stud prefix. Entry Fee £5.00 per pony or £6.00 per pony if entered on the day

**Special A) Bewcastle Boy Blue Inter Group Championship.** Highest placed eligible pony (to be eligible to enter the pony needs to be owned and exhibited by a current MWSG member who resides, and whose pony is kept in the MWSG area) owned by a fully paid up member from each In-Hand Class. Entry to this class will be free with your membership. The qualifying pony (along with the qualifier from the Spring Festival of Fells will represent the Midlands West Group for the Bewcastle Boy Blue Inter Area Final at the Southern Breed Show on Sunday 11th September 2022 at Berkshire College of Agriculture SL6 6QR. MWSG membership can be taken on the day of the show. If eligible, please only enter the championship if you intend to go to the Southern Breed Show.

Class 15: Traditional Ridden Class (Walk and Trot only)

Class 16: Open Ridden Class

Class 17: Veteran Ridden (15 years or over)
