- i) Won an open NPS affiliated M&M Ridden class
- ii) Won a class at an Olympia, HOYS or RIHS qualifying round
- iii) Qualified for HOYS or RIHS
- iv) Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden final at the NPS Summer Championship show
- v) Qualified for the M&M Ridden Championship final at Olympia in previous years or in the current year

Ponies must be ridden in one of the snaffle bridles illustrated in the NPS Rule Book.

11. **The NPS / Peasedown Stud M&M Intermediate Fell Ridden**

Open to pure bred registered Fell stallions, mares and geldings five years old or over

A pony shall not be eligible to compete if it has qualified before 1st January of the current year for either:-

- i) The M&M Ridden Championship Final at The Horse of the Year Show or
- ii) The NPS/Baileys Horse Feeds M&M Supreme Ridden Championship Final at Olympia.

12. Novice Pony in its first season under saddle **Snaffle bridles only. (stallions excluded)**
13. Novice Pony Not to have won 2 firsts in ridden classes. **Any suitable bit. (stallions excluded)**
14. Traditional Ridden. **Walk and Trot only**
15. Open Ridden Class
16. Veteran Pony under saddle. Pony to be 16 years and over.

RULES

Exhibitors MUST be current fully paid up Members of either or both of the Fell Pony Society or Dales Pony Society. Please note that in the case of Dales Pony Classes; the Pony Handler must also be a fully paid up Member of the Dales Pony Society.

Any person riding within the show premises must wear a riding hat conforming to current BSI hat safety standards. Hard hats to be worn by all competitors in Young Handler classes 18 and 44.

Ponies must be registered with either the Fell Pony Society or the Dales Pony Society.

The current showing rules of each Breed Society apply to the appropriate classes. Please contact the Breed Society concerned if you need a copy.

A Points Trophy will be awarded to the Fell or Dales Pony gaining the most points on the day. Points awarded for places 1st to 6th in all classes

Stallion owners and exhibitors, please note that stallions at all times must be handled or ridden at the show by a person 16 years or over (on 1st January 2009). This show actively encourages novice pony entries in all disciplines and as such stallions must be closely and actively observed whilst on the show field.

Should entries be large, classes will be split.

NPS MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND QUALIFYING ROUNDS

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible.

Qualifying Rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS Members and Non-Members and at breed shows ponies owned by non-members may qualify for the championship final. However, they must become adult showing members within 14 days in order to be eligible for entry into the final of the competition.

The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the Final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than 3rd place. Judges and/or stewards are requested to check membership cards prior to presenting the qualifying rosettes. NPS Adult/Standard members will be required to upgrade to Adult/Showing to enter the Final.

COURT FARM QUALIFIER

This show is a qualifier for the Court Farm Ridden Dales Pony of the Year Championship held at the Dales Performance Show on Sunday 30th August 2009. It will be awarded to the Dales Pony Ridden Champion (NPS Ridden Dales Class winners NOT ELIGIBLE).

COMPLAINTS

This show has been organised to encourage entries from novice and experienced competitors alike. We want this to be an enjoyable show. With that in mind, we hope exhibitors will come and have a nice day with their ponies. If you really must complain, your complaint must be accompanied by a fee of £40.00, which will only be returned if the complaint is upheld.

DIRECTIONS TO THE FIELD

From the North, leave the M6 at Junction 40, go south, taking signs for A66, at next roundabout take 4th Exit to Clifton (A6). Drive through Eamont Bridge, past Lowther Caravan Park on right, and take 2nd left turn, field is on the right.

If travelling from the East on A66, at first Penrith roundabout take 1st exit which will then take you through Eamont Bridge as above.
