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Come and indulge your enthusiasm for all things Hairy Pony!! The camp will run from Friday 7th May to Sunday 9th May - and hopefully this year we will be sun bathing and not swimming!

This is our third annual camp and will run on a similar format to last year. We begin with a ride on the Friday evening with instruction beginning on Saturday morning. Over the course of the weekend you will work in small groups of similar (pony and/or rider) abilities.

Instruction will cover flatwork, show jumping and working hunter. Riders will work in their own comfort zone under the guidance of encouraging and supportive instructors. There will be a demonstration on Saturday evening and the weekend finale will be fun camp competition (dressage, working hunter etc). All riders will receive a participation rosette and there will be competition rosettes too!

The camp costs £80 per pony and rider (£40 for riders who wish to come for one day only). Spectators are welcome at a charge of £5 to cover food costs.
