CLASSES

FELL PONY CLASSES

- Class 1: Stallions (3year olds and over must be fully licensed)
- Class 2: Geldings, 4 years and over
- Class 3: Mares without foal at foot, 4 years and over
- Class 4: Mare with foal at foot
- Class 5: Foal (To be at least 3 weeks old on show day and eligible for registration in the Fell Pony Stud Book)
- Class 6: Yearling Colt, Filly or Gelding
- Class 7: Two Year Old Colt, Filly or Gelding
- Class 8: Three Year Old Filly or Gelding

Special A) FPS Midlands West Support Group Championship. Highest placed eligible pony, owned by a fully paid up member, resident in the Area, from each Fell Pony In-Hand Class. Champion and Reserve will represent Midlands West for the Bewcastle Boy Blue Inter Area Final at the Southern Breed Show on Sunday 10th September 2017 at Berkshire College of Agriculture SL6 6QR.

Special B) Youngstock Championship (1st & 2nd Prize winners from classes 5, 6, 7 & 8)

Special C) Adult Championship (1st & 2nd Prize winners from classes 1, 2 3 & 4)

FELL PONY RIDDEN CLASSES

- Class 9: Novice Pony in its first season under saddle (Snaffle bridles only)
- Class 10: Novice Pony (Not to have won two firsts in ridden classes) (Snaffle bridles only)
- Class 11: Traditional Ridden Class (Walk and Trot only)
- Class 12: Open Ridden Class

Special G) Ridden Championship (1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 9, 10, 11 and 12)

Overall Fell Pony Champion (Champion & Reserve Youngstock, Adult and Ridden Pony to compete)

DALES PONY CLASSES

- Class 13: Stallion (3 year olds and over must be fully licensed)
- Class 14: Geldings 4 years and over
- Class 15: Geld Mare (without foal at foot)
- Class 16: Mare with foal at foot
- Class 17: Foal (To be at least 3 weeks old on show day and eligible for registration in the Dales Pony Stud Book)
- Class 18: Yearling Colt, Filly or Gelding
- Class 19: Two year old Colt, Filly or Gelding
- Class 20: Three year old Filly or Gelding

Special D) Youngstock Championship (1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 17, 18, 19 and 20)

Special E) Adult Championship (1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 13, 14, 15 and 16)

Special F) Rosette for the best Section B pony

DALES PONY RIDDEN CLASSES

- Class 21: Novice Pony in its first season under saddle (Snaffle bridles only)
- Class 22 Novice Pony, not to have won two firsts in ridden Classes (Snaffle bridles only)
- Class 23: Traditional Ridden (Walk and trot only)
- Class 24: Open Ridden

Special H) Ridden Championship (1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 21, 22, 23 and 24)

The overall ridden champion & reserve qualify for the final Dales Pony Society ridden pony of the year, to be held at the DPS Spring show, May 2018. If the champion and reserve have already qualified then the qualification will pass down the line.

Overall Dales Pony Champion (Champion & Reserve Youngstock, Adult and Ridden Pony to compete)

COMBINED CLASSES

(Open to Dales & Fells –rosettes to the best of each breed)

To be held during the lunch break (following the In Hand Judging Sections) - Please check your timings, as the Breed rings will not be held up for these classes

Class 25: Trekking Class (Tack to be appropriate and rider and pony to be suitably dressed (high viz) and equipped for a long distance ride)

Class 26: Novice Handler (handler not to have been placed first in an In- Hand class)

Class 27: Novice Rider (rider never to have been placed first in ridden classes)

In both these classes, rosettes to best junior under 14 years, and best Over 50!

Class 28: Progeny Pairs class (2 ponies in hand, either by the same stallion, out of the same mare, sire and offspring or dam and offspring)

DRIVING CLASS

(Open to Dales & Fells –rosettes to the best of each breed)

- **The two highest placed ponies in each section at each qualifying show will qualify for the 2018 NPS Supreme Final to be held at Addington Manor Equestrian Centre, Addington, Buckinghamshire in April 2018 and also be eligible to be chosen to represent their Breed, NPS Area or other team in the Team Challenge which will be incorporated into the 2018 Championship Final.**
- **Qualifying rounds are open to competitors from the UK and elsewhere. All qualifiers will receive a qualification card.**
- **The Final will run in accordance with the 2017/2018 NPS Dressage Rules which will be available to all NPS Members. Copyright All Rights Reserved 2016**
- **Horse/ponies must be ridden at the Final by the qualifying rider.**
- **Those qualifying for the Final must be fully paid up Dressage, Qualifying or Life members of the NPS for 2018 in order to compete at the 2018 Supreme Dressage Final.**
- **Please state on entry form which of the above sections you are eligible for.**
- **Please note: Snaffle bits only (No Wilkie Snaffles), and no spurs allowed.**

SHOW RULES

1. Exhibitors of Fell and Dales ponies must be current members of either the Fell Pony Society and/or the Dales Pony Society. The showing rules of each Society apply to the appropriate classes.
2. Classes are only open to ponies registered in the Fell Pony stud book and the Dales Pony stud book.
3. The current showing rules of each Breed Society apply to the appropriate classes. Please contact the Breed Society concerned for a copy
4. The organisers reserve the right to combine or divide any class as necessary. Efforts will be made to prevent classes clashing, but in the event of a clash, classes will not be held up and the exhibitor must decide which to enter.

COMPLAINTS: We do not encourage complaints. This is intended as a fun show, to be enjoyed by all. If you really must complain, your complaint must be accompanied by a fee of £20.00, which will only be returned if the complaint is upheld.
